The second and third day (22nd, 23rd June, 2023) the conference deliberations will be at the Dept. of Linguistics (ONV Bhavan), University of Kerala, Karyavattom. There can be many shortcomings due to lack of proper facilities, but we hope the participants will bear with us. From the organizers' part, maximum possible efforts will be done for a comfortable stay and for academically fruitful discussions in the 50th All India Conference of Dravidian Linguists. HOW TO REACH KARYAVATTOM UNIVERSITY CAMPUS AND MENAMKULAM ISDL CAMPUS

The Karyavattom Campus of the University of Kerala where the Conference Sessions are arranged is about 13 km north of Trivandrum Central Railway Station on the side of NH 544 (old number NH 47) (Trivandrum - Attingal/Quilon/ Alleppey/Ernakulam) bus route. One can get prepaid auto rickshaws or Uber Taxi/Autorickshaw to Karyavattom Campus from Airport / Railway station. The Trivandrum Transport stand is just opposite to the Central Railway Station and hence one can come to Karyavattom by Kerala State Transport Corporation Buses also.
